- The Modern Consortium for Refuelling Aircraft Co. Ltd. (MCRA) established upon a Joint Venture of Arabian Petroleum Supply Company (APSCO) and Al-Shams National Global Energy Company (formerly Al-Bakri International Energy Company Limited (BIECO)). MCRA is the first private company in Saudi Arabia managing fuel farm with storage capacity 36 million litres, hydrant operation and delivering quality into-plane services of Jet A-1 at King Fahd International Airport Dammam in line with Joint Inspection Group (JIG) standards, the recognised global organisation in the field.
- The company also works in cooperation with Kuwait International Aviation Company Limited (Q8 Aviation), which is a JIG guarantor member in order to obtain technical support services for its entire operation. Those international experts are visiting MCRA on a regular basis to inspect and verify operations periodically and repeatedly each year to ensure maintaining the highest international standards. Q8 currently manages and operates several fuel farm and into plane fuel facilities at major airports in Europe, Asia, Australia and Africa.
- MCRA depends on highly qualified engineering, technical and administrative Saudi and expat staff having excellent international expertise in the field. It also relies on its partners in continuous inspection program to monitor the safety, maintenance and operation procedures and their conformity with international requirements.








Safety is the foremost and integral part in all MCRA's business decisions and strongly believes that all incidents and accidents are preventable.
